Special Local Watercraft Ordinance for Lake James

Roscommon County
WC-72-15-002 LAKE JAMES SLOW-NO WAKE SPEED

On the waters of Lake James, located in Backus Township, T22N, R2W, Section 19 of Roscommon County, State of Michigan, beginning at Roscommon Road and ending at the entrance to Shadow Lake (44.28809, -84.60822), it is unlawful for the operator of a vessel to exceed a slow- no-wake speed.

Slow-no wake speed means a very slow speed whereby the wake or wash created by the vessel would be minimal.

The boundaries of the area described above shall be marked with signs and/or with buoys and maintained by the Township. All buoys must be placed as provided in a permit issued by the Department of Natural Resources and be in conformance with the State Uniform Waterway marking System.

Effective Date: This Ordinance shall take effect on written approval of Department of Natural Resources

ADOPTED: April 04, 2016

This ordinance has been adopted by the Backus Township Board at a regular meeting scheduled by the Backus Township Board on April 04, 2016 and will be published April 21, 2016 as Ordinance No. 12.
